Main actions of the year:

15 Tour de France regattas with 2 regattas with more than 30 boats (Vassivière and FFVoile Championship)

Prepare French Européenne Micro in Annecy on September 8th - 9th.

Neptune 5.50 still very popular as 30 boats are racing.

Flyer 5.50 fleet is now of 11 boats and a class association Flyer Class France is in progress.

Microsail Class has been renewed and will promote the Microsail with 20 active boats.

Next year projects:

20 Tour de France Regattas, including 4 Classic Tour and 1 Micro National Championship.

Micro National Championship in lake of Vassivière (near Limoges) from 18 to 19 of May.

After Annecy test, we could propose Euro Micro regattas for 2019.

Technical Committee:

Clarify text on carbon features authorized / some French crew did not exactly understand the text.

Identification of a boat is done through: Builder identification plaque, ISAF plaque and Sail number

On line certificate: all measurements certificate to be digitalized; already done for France

This will allow all national measurers to have access to an unique database.
