President Report;

We still miss a treasurer, Jean Louis Hayes and I are covering the activity, with some limits, due to lack of time.

Treasurer role remains vacant.

Technical Committee update / Manfred Bauendahl (see report attached)

Philippe Bonnemains, due to personal problems, has to stop his role as French Measurer Action: Regis to check with Philippe Bonnemains is available to go further in his relation with World Sailing.

During Micro WC races, the International Measurer request a dedicated boat. Action : Regis IMCCA has to accept new Class rule wording; documents circulating in countries. In the future, change of class rules will be possible.

Cruiser equipment: Manfred to propose a vote to TC for amendment, based on France proposal..

Financial update;

See enclosed end of October 2020 Financial Report done by JL Hayes Slovakia will send 2020 fees payment before year end.

Country Update (see countries report attached)

FRA:Micro WC in Martigues: Only 50 berth places will be available in the harbor, other boats will be mooring on anchor. Berth places will be allocated to the first 50 boats registered. Euro Micro is planned for 3 to 5 April in Paris. Virtual regatta to be organized in 2021.

POL:Activity increasing , 4 new boats to be built in 2021. Planning 10 boats at WC. Euro Micro at Plock (lake)

GER: Euro Micro at Zulpich, date to be defined, but will be one week before or after France Euro micro New Sailart 18: need to check if fitting Micro Class Rules.

SVK: look for a new more windy place for Euro Micro

ITA: Will organize a Euro Micro in Venice area end of may or beginning of June

IMCCA MEETING 2020

REPORT OF THE CHIEF MEASURER 2020

1. State of the class rules development (wording)

The project, formatting of the current Class Rules in the standard class rule format, was finished in 2018.

In 2019 World Sailing technical specialist Hendrik Plate and our new CEO, Philippe Bonnemains, try to work together on the wording of the class rules.

But never in time, Philippe Bonnemains get an answer from Hendrik Plate. His delay was often more than five months.

In 2020 Philippe often tries to get feedback from his mailed updates to him, but he never got an answer.

From March 2020 to August 2020 World Sailing does not work because of Covid 19 Pandemie. In August 2020 I mailed a request to Hendrik and got an answer with delay in October.

I took forward this answer to Philippe Bonnemains, but never got a reply from him.

At the moment, I am not sure if our CEO decides to go forward with the wording of the project, or he wants to take down his work.

I want to say Thank you for the important work of Philippe Bonnemains and hope he wants to finish it.

2. Projects

- I organize a short "training on the job" seminar in Marina Liptove, Slowakia for the equipment inspectors
- and a workshop for the national measurer of Slowakia.

3. World Championship 2019, Measurement in Slowakia, Bobrovnik

Organization:

In parts, there was a good organization between the chief measurer and the organizer. All requested measurement stations, material or personal was on place. Three national measurers: Peter Repan, Kurey Lubos, Matei Haducik from Slovakia make a good work of measurement. Additionally, the volunteers were very motivated.

Equipment control was, optimized so that most competitors need about 2,5 hours. The organization fully realized my equipment plane. :-) Only the crane to make checks of the weight was not there during the last three days of the world championship.

Chief measurer equipment and role:

There are some points to change in the future:

The chief measurer has the same role as the jury or the race officer.

He has to make the competition fair and so he has to take control before the start and after the finish line. For that, he needs a (rubber) boat with a flag "M" or "TC". But this boat was not on the place and not planed.

Furthermore, if the organizer wants to thank all race officials on stage during the price Giving, the chief measurer is to invite too at the same time.

b) - proposal of the TC member: A1.04: sink not compulsory during the races.- entered on the list for the next class rule amendments

Today, no more Cruisers have skink and storage on bord, and French MicroClass need to change this rule officially.

Kráľovský kolotoč is a regatta that becomes a tradition in Slovak Micro community. It started at Liptovská Mara, but due to a new base of organising club Kolotočári developing at VD Kráľová it was decided, that the regatta will move there. It traditionally serves also as a training session for less experienced as well as brand new Micro sailors. It is usually also an opening regatta of the year, but it was moved this year due to the pandemic.

Slovak championship is a rotating regatta, that moves every year. West, Middle and East part of the country alternate in hosting the regatta and one of the local clubs is responsible. It is an open class regatta (with touristic cruiser division). The Micro class national championship is a part of this regatta, as it was this season.

NEWS

- Base of Bratislava based club Kolotočári is continuing to grow at VD Kráľová (<u>check it</u> <u>out</u>). A container was built this year and the plan is to build a fully working marina with the help of local hotel.
- SVK4 changed the owner, the original owner wanted to sell the boat, so Kolotočári club bought the boat for another team that is growing of this most active Micro class club in Slovakia

PLANS FOR THE NEXT YEAR

- **Euro Micro Cup Slovakia** is to be held from the 3rd to the 5th of July. 3 sailing days are planned, Saturday, Sunday and also Monday. The place is to be decided.
- SVK66, SVK4 and SVK101 are planning a trip to the World Championship in France.

No boats can be buyed in Germany. Most boatyards doesn't seem to be interested to sell boats to german Sailors. Attempts of communication to boatyards in Poland, France and Serbia fails regularly allthough they are in english language. There are big difficulties to get Spare-parts for foreign boats (Boatique, Mawamed,...) There is an interisting development with maybe some News on boat-sector, but nothing to be said out loud at this moment.

German Micro Class Association in 2020:

The number of participants on regattas is rising on very low level. Only 3 Races could be organized because of Covid-Shutdown.
